

Local Scholarships 2018

1. **Band Boosters Scholarship** – Students must have been in the band 4 years.
2. **Dee Ora Masonic Lodge #715 Scholarship** – Anyone may apply.
3. **Fernie Ramos Jr. Memorial Scholarship** – Any graduating senior may apply.
4. **First United Methodist Church of Sonora** – Applicants must be an active member of the church.
5. **First United Methodist Church of Sonora Charlotte Wilson Music Scholarship** – Applicants must be interested in music and pursuing music as a major/minor in college or participating through extra-curricular activities while in college.
6. **Health Occupations Student Association** – Students who have taken HST (nursing) may apply.
7. **Jack Neill/David Law Memorial Scholarship** – Anyone may apply. This renewable scholarship will continue the entire time you are in school.
8. **Julia Zaragoza and Paula Hernandez Memorial Scholarship** – Anyone may apply.
9. **Louis and Adelmira Perez Scholarship** – Scholarship is for students who will be attending Angelo State University.
10. **Louise Adele Davis Dermody Memorial Scholarship** – Applicants must be in the top 10% of the graduating class.
11. **Oliver and Annabel Wuest Scholarship** – Students applying must be in a woodshop class during senior year.
12. **Sonora Golf Club Scholarship** – Students applying must have been on the Sonora HS golf team for at least two years, including senior year.
13. **Southwest Holdings Scholarship** –

The Southwest Holdings Scholarship is intended to assist students who are planning to attend college and major in **science, math, engineering or a related technical field** with the intention of pursuing a career in one of these industrial fields. This scholarship is to encourage students to pursue difficult university degree plans to ultimately contribute to future technological advances in our society and has absolutely nothing to do with economic need. This is not intended for students pursuing coaching or other athletic disciplines.

In a separate attached paragraph(s), please address the following questions: In what field do I plan to major in college? What type of job or work do I want to pursue to utilize this degree? And most importantly why do I want to choose this area of study and what do I hope to accomplish? You must write this yourself, please do not have a parent or sibling write for you; we will be able to tell.

Students selected for this scholarship will be given a sheet of instructions. After registering for classes in the field you indicated on your application, you will need to bring your registration slip, student ID number and mailing address for the University or institution you will be attending. A check will be mailed to the school to be applied to your account.

Please be honest about your intentions, and apply only if you actually plan to register for one of these fields of study at school. If you are awarded this scholarship and then register for a degree plan other than that which you indicated on your application, the financial assistance will be awarded to someone else.

14. **Sonora Downtown Lions Club Scholarships** – Any graduating senior can apply. Criteria students should be aware of when applying for this scholarship include:
 - Address how well they have done in school, including awards, honors and achievements
 - Articulate college ambitions and career goals
 - Detail volunteer work and extra-curricular activities
 15. **St. Ann's Catholic Church Knight of Columbus Scholarship** – any graduating senior can apply.
 16. **Sonora Women's Club Scholarship** – Girls may apply. Application must also include a copy of your HS transcript with ACT/SAT scores. **Essay required** with information about your educational goals and future plans. Legacy scholarships will also be given. If you have a family member (mother, grandmother) who is or was a member of the Women's Club, be sure to submit an application.
 17. **St. John's Episcopal Church Scholarship** – No application is required. Recipients must be an active member of the church and acolyte.
 18. **Sutton County 4-H Scholarship** – **This scholarship has its own application and deadline.** You must be a 4-H member to apply. Pick-up application at the County Extension Office or get a copy from Mrs. Friess.
 19. **Sutton County Days Association** – Scholarship is given to Miss Sutton County and runners-up. No application required.
 20. **The Bank and Trust Scholarship** - **Applicants must be in the top 10% of class** and exhibit extraordinary leadership abilities. You must attend a 4-year university, community college, trade school or technical school.
 21. **West Central Wireless Scholarship** – Selection based on academics and financial need.
 22. **John and Mildred Cauthorn Charitable Trust Scholarship** – Applications will be ready for pick-up beginning April 15th in room 206 of the Mercantile Building on Main Street. Office is open Mondays and Tuesdays from 10:00-4:30. If you have trouble catching Ms. Kerbow, please see Mrs. Friess.
